Teardown only AFTER 6:00 pm Saturday. No overnight parking.

2. Your display area is **12 FEET** (frontage) **by 12 FEET** (depth). *Hydro is not available at the vendor sites.* Alternatively, generators such as Whisper Power, are welcome as the alternative use of hydro and must comply with the Canadian Standard Association.

3. **The Canada 150 Committee reserves the right to review and/or refuse questionable products at any time and to limit the number of exhibitors in one category.**

Deadline for Applications is June 1.

4. Please ensure the security of your products and remove them after 6:00pm.
